# AgeSong, Hampton join in S.F.

[AgeSong](#), which runs New Age assisted living centers in several Bay Area locales, early this month launched a partnership with the [Hampton Health Clinic](#) to provide on-site medical care at its two centers in San Francisco.

Both AgeSong and Hampton Health Ltd., a geriatric medicine specialist, are privately owned and based in San Francisco. Hampton's medical director is John Fullerton, M.D.

Starting early this month, the new arrangement brought on-site care — including access to at least one physician — to AgeSong's Hayes Valley and Laguna Grove assisted living centers. Nader Shabahangi, AgeSong's founder and CEO, said that as residents age and in many cases get sicker, they tend to need more care from geriatric specialists, hence the Hampton connection.

As part of the agreement, Theresa Kemnitz is the on-site physician and associate medical director at AgeSong's San Francisco facilities. Fullerton, Kemnitz and other providers will provide flu shots, B12 and other injections, as well as on-site consultation and care.
