Basic Care is an Opportunity To Interact

One of the most humbling aspects of aging is needing help for the most basic everyday tasks. It is a standard for providers to offer assistance with “Activities of Daily Living,” or ADLs. At AgeSong however, every opportunity to engage with Elders is important... after all, helping with an Elder’s personal appearance may be the first interaction of the day. It can be a meaningful time to connect and engage, or it can be approached as a task to be efficiently checked off a list. Many providers use the word “dignity” but what is dignified about “being washed?”

Unless the activity is approached as an opportunity to connect and truly assist, it is custodial. Nature quickly reallocates resources. The adage, “Use it or lose it,” particularly applies to Elders. If the motion of brushing hair is suddenly replaced by a well-meaning caregiver doing it instead — because maybe it takes longer — shoulder mobility will dramatically decrease. Finally, study after study confirm social interaction is essential for health and well-being. Every moment an AgeSong Carepartner spends with an Elder is precious.

Transitions, Short-Term Stays — Gerowellness Interns Make the Difference

At AgeSong, Gerowellness Interns provide counselling services and support for new Elders and families during the sometimes difficult transition into community living.

Whether the individual is coming from hospital, home, rehab or another community, Interns keep in close contact for a minimum of two weeks, or longer if needed.



Eldership Education and Training — Learning Community
